Germany: Humboldt Foundation International Climate Protection Fellowship for Young Climate Experts from Developing Countries. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Deadline 1 March, 2017

Netherlands: Holland Scholarships for Bachelor's and Master's Candidates. Students from ASEAN Eligible


